10) WORLD FINALS

Welcome to the Windhoek Lager International Pairs Season 6.

Important Notice: All Clubs may have a maximum of 4 qualifying events during Season 6.

1) TIME FRAME:

- a. The **Windhoek Lager International Pairs SA** Club qualifying events take place from **1 January 2021**.
- b. Club Qualifying events will be completed by **31 July 2021**.
- c. The **Regional Finals** will be completed by **31 August 2021**.
- d. The **National Finals** will take place in **September 2021**. The venue will be announced.
- e. The **World Finals** – in the Algarve, Portugal will take place from **26 to 30 October 2021**.

2) PREAMBLE:

2016 Saw the launch of the 1st season of the Windhoek Lager International Pairs. It has been an amazing success. International Pairs Worldwide was created in England in 1998 and started as a regional inter-club “pairs” competition in the Hampshire area to celebrate the Millennium. That was 23 years ago, and the tournament has grown into an International event of some significance. The success of International Pairs as a concept has been its simplicity and in enabling participating countries to hold qualifying events through which the process to identify pairs of ordinary club golfers to represent their country at the International Pairs World Final each year.

The Coordinators and Organizers – African Sports Management (Pty) Ltd, in coordination with the sponsors, reserve the right to change, amend or add any rules, regulations and conditions they deem required necessary to ensure the successful running of the Tournament.

The tournament committee will consist of members of Windhoek Lager and African Sports Management, whose decision shall be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

By entering the WLIPSA event players confirm that they will abide and accept the rules as set out in the TOURNAMENT RULES, REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS.

3) SPONSORS:

- a. **Windhoek Lager** is the Title Rights Holder and Main Sponsor of the tournament, and they make it possible for the event to remain extremely cost-effective.
- b. **The Pro Shop, Legacy Hotel Group, Callaway, Odyssey and Kulula** provide great support to the tournament and the participants, adding significant value to the event.

4) CLUB INFORMATION:

- a) The objective is to retain the image and reputation of **WLIPSA** as a “tournament of integrity”.
- b) All SAGA/GOLFRSA affiliated golf clubs will be eligible to participate in the **WLIPSA** tournament.
- c) It is now the largest amateur pairs event in South Africa.
- d) **WLIPSA** is a competitive, cost-effective Betterball Stableford competition.
- e) Any SAGA/GOLFRSA affiliated golf club may register and generate qualifying pairs from their **Club Qualifying** events.
- f) The tournament is effectively the inter-club “PAIRS” championship of South Africa.
- g) International Pairs events can be played as men’s, women’s, and mixed pairs.
- h) A **Club Qualifier** can be held in conjunction with an existing club competition on the club calendar, where the winners also gain qualification to the Regional Finals.
- i) Visiting pairs are not eligible to qualify for the Regional Finals. The club may allow visitors to register to play in the competition. The club may allow them

to win a prize – but they may not receive an invitation to the Regional Finals. (They will need to play in a **WLIPSA** Club Qualifying event at their home club.)

- j) The above also applies to guests who may be playing with a member – they may not represent the club at the Regional Finals.
- k) With **WLIPSA**, all club handicap golfers can compete for the right to represent their Club, their Region and possibly even South Africa in an International event.
- l) The organizers reserve the right to host additional qualifying events to cater for those players whose clubs do not participate in the club qualifying events (where members of the same Club will be able to enter as a pair).
- m) The simple process is that:
 - Pairs play at their home **Club Qualifier** and, dependant on the size of the field, a number of players receive invitations to represent their golf club at the Regional Finals:
 - i. In qualifying events, **one pair** qualifies from a field of the minimum number of 15 pairs. **Two pairs** qualify from a field comprising of 30 pairs etc. (as below).
 - ii. A club may have morning fields, afternoon fields and a maximum of **four qualifying events** in the qualifying time frame/window period (1 January 2021 to 31 July 2021).
 - iii. Two 9-hole golf clubs can combine their qualifying event, subject to approval by the Coordinators, to ensure a larger field.
 - iv. Ladies' sections of affiliated golf clubs can combine and host a separate qualifier to meet the criteria of a minimum of 15 participating pairs (subject to the approval of the Coordinators)
 - v. The organizers reserve the right to have separate Ladies Only qualifying events where ladies from the same club will be able to enter as a pair.
 - vi. If a club has one field for the whole day, then very simply: 15 pairs = 1 Regional Final place; 30 pairs = 2 places, 45 pairs = 3 places and thereafter 1 place for every additional 15 pairs will represent the club/s at the Regional Finals.
- n) All this for **R100 (one hundred rand)** entry fee at every club qualifier. Each player receives a pair of branded Windhoek Lager golf balls.
- o) **20% (twenty percent)** of the entry fee will go towards prizes at your Club Qualifier. Clubs can buy prizes from their local Pro-shop. If the Club does not have a local Pro-shop, the Club can purchase prizes from other suppliers.

- p) Once qualified, Players do not pay any further entry fees for the Regional Finals, The SA Final, or the World Final.

5) CLUB QUALIFYING:

- a) The tournament comprises of a Series of **Club Qualifying events (additional qualifying events as per 4(l) above).**
- b) The competition entry fee for all Club Qualifying events is **R100 (one hundred rand)** per player per qualifying event, payable to the club.
- c) Only club members with an official handicap index may qualify at a **Windhoek Lager International Pairs South Africa Club Qualifying event.**
- d) The competition shall be played as Betterball Stableford in accordance with the rules of golf as laid down by the R&A of St Andrews and Rule 6.2a of GOLFRSA/SAGA (85%), together with any local rules approved by participating club competition committees – the winning pairs will be the pairs as determined by the club competition committee i.e., club count out procedure.
- e) The use of tees will be decided as per the handicap rules of Golf. Should 1 player decide to play of a certain tee the player’s partner can play off a different tee (This is subject to the Club’s local Rules).
- f) Any disputes in **Club Qualifiers** shall be settled by the relevant club competition committee, whose decision shall be final.
- g) The tournament is **open to all golfers of eighteen years or older** at the time of the Club Qualifying event who are affiliated members of a SAGA/GOLFRSA affiliated Golf Club and have an official handicap index.
- h) Only club competitions registered with the Tournament Coordinators by the participating clubs will be deemed to be an official club qualifier.
- i) Club winners can only be officially registered for the Regional Finals once the Tournament Coordinators have received **full payment of all competition entry fees due and the duly completed Players Registration Forms containing the necessary details of each entrant.**
- j) **It is a condition of qualifying that the club pay all fees related to the event and return the Players Registration Forms within 7 working days after completion of the qualifying event to ASM.**
- k) In addition, all organizers of qualifying events will be obliged to confirm that all competition rules have been complied with.

- l) Once a club has registered their qualifying pair/s and payment has been remitted to the Tournament Coordinators, no monies are refundable under any circumstances.
- m) If one player of a qualifying pair is no longer a member of the Club or unable to play in the Regional Finals for reasons of health, bereavement, business or any other reason, the remaining player may nominate a substituted partner who **must** have played in the same qualifying event. This then becomes the qualifying pair.
- n) In the event of an original club qualifying pair is no longer members of the Club or not being able to play in the Regional Finals, the club may substitute such a pair. The only stipulation is that any substitute pair **must** have played in the same Club Qualifying event and whose details must be **present on the Players Registration Forms**. There shall be no further changes to that pair during the competition and any future unavailability of either partner shall result in withdrawal of the pair as a team.
- o) Club winners – and other qualifiers as determined by the size of the field – will win a place in the Regional Finals as qualifiers. There may be further prizes from the club and/or associated sponsors in accordance with **Rule 4-2g**.

6) PLAYER INFORMATION:

- a) It is one of the biggest golf tournaments for amateur club golfers in the world.
- b) The final stages are conducted along the lines of a professional Tournament, with no count-outs and any “ties” being settled by way of a play-off (if possible).
- c) Hundreds of thousands of golfers have played in qualifying events around the world.
- d) Each qualifying stage is unique, and every club golfer should try and experience what it is like.
- e) **WLIPSA** is a tournament that facilitates “competitive golf played in a fun way”.
- f) The process enables thousands of golfers to represent their golf clubs and to compete for the **Windhoek Lager International Pairs SA Championship**.
- g) The qualifying process culminates in two pairs of ordinary amateur club golfers representing South Africa at the World Finals.

- h) The entry fee is **R100** (100 hundred rand) per player per qualifying event and there are no further payments required to represent one's club, region, or country.
- i) **No payment** is required at the **Regional Finals**, where all costs, including green fees, players' halfway house, snacks and some drink/s are covered by **Windhoek Lager** as the Title Rights Holders of the tournament. **(Caddies or carts, where applicable are for the players' own accounts, as well as the player's transport/travel to this stage.)**
- j) **No payment** is required at the SA Finals. All costs including air travel, accommodation, all meals, green fees, pair of drinks and other surprises are covered by **Windhoek Lager**. **(Caddies or carts where applicable are for the players' own account)**
- k) Finally, **Windhoek Lager** also covers the costs of our South African representatives attending the World Finals of the **International Pairs in Portugal**.
- l) Simply enter at your golf club. If your club has not registered to hold a Club Qualifying event, encourage them to do so in order that you may participate.
- m) A golfer can only qualify to represent the golf club at which that golfer is a full member. (If the club where he/she is handicapped does not host a club qualifying event.)
- n) A player may only qualify once for the Regional Finals. If a player has played in two qualifying events with two different partners, and achieved qualification in both events, the first registered qualification by date will be deemed to be the only qualification by that player for the Regional Finals.
- o) Any **player** having qualified and played in the World Finals may not qualify for the World Finals again for the next **FIVE WORLD FINALS**.
- p) Any player who has qualified for and played in the National Final may not qualify for the next **two National Finals**.
- q) He/she may, however, represent his/her club at the Regional Finals **BUT MAY NOT** attend the National Finals for a period of **TWO YEARS/TWO NATIONAL FINALS**.
- r) Right of admission to the tournament may be reserved.
- s) **All participants playing in the National Final will be required to sign a Code of Conduct.**

7) HANDICAPPING:

- a) All players must be in good standing at their club.
- b) All players must have a current official handicap index.
- c) Players shall use their handicap index according to the handicapping system in operation, as implemented by the South African Golf Association/GOLFRSA.
- d) During the Final Stages of the Tournament (**Regional, National and World Finals**); golfers will receive 85% allowance of their Course Handicap, which complies with the International Handicapping Rules of the Tournament and Rule 6.2a as per the Rules of GOLFRSA/SAGA-**(Playing Handicap=Course Handicap X 85%)**.
- e) The handicap index off which all players qualify for the Final Stages shall be the "LOW HI" achieved in the preceding 365 days (85% of Course Handicap as per 7(d) above).
- f) Furthermore, a player may only play in the Final Stages off a handicap index of their lowest handicap index over the last 12 months (LOW HI).
- g) **Should any player make an error with a score submission for handicapping or fail to submit a score from any round during any stage of the competition in which that player is involved, then that player and their partner will be required to withdraw from further participation in the event – even if such submission or omission was a mistake. Scores must be submitted within the time frame stipulated by the SAGA/GOLFRSA handicapping system (before a penalty score is recorded).**
- h) As with the above point and as with Professional golfers, should a competitor sign for an incorrect score during any stage of the event, that player **and** their partner will be required to withdraw from further participation in the event.

8) REGIONAL FINALS:

- a) The number of National Final places available at the Regional Final events is based on ratios. For example, if there are 200 qualifying pairs throughout South Africa and Region 'X' has 40 qualifying pairs, then 20% of the places in the National Finals will be available at that Regional Final.
- b) **Windhoek Lager International Pairs SA** Regional finals may take place at any affiliated golf club in South Africa.
- c) Regional Finals will be held around the country.

- d) Qualifiers from areas outside the designated Regional Finals areas will be allocated to a Regional Final closest to their home club and will be responsible for their own travel arrangements to that location.
- e) A maximum total of 24 (twenty-four) pairs from the Regional finals will travel to the SA finals. (As well as maximum of 6 Ladies pairs)
- f) The Regional Finals are contested by all qualifying pairs from the Clubs and additional qualifying events (as per 4(l) above).
- g) Regional Final venues will be determined by the Tournament Coordinators, whose decision is final.
- h) Where there may be more than one venue for the Regional Finals in any region, qualifying pairs will be allocated to one of the venues by the Tournament Coordinators, whose decision is final.
- i) The event format for the Regional Finals is an 18-hole Betterball Stableford competition as per Rule 6.2 (As per 7(d) above)
- j) The **qualifiers** for the National Finals will be those players with the highest Betterball Score along with the next highest score, dependent on the number of places available.
- k) In the event of a tie, a **play-off** as opposed to a count out will determine the winners and any additional qualifying pair/s. In the event of a cessation of play in the play-offs due to unavoidable circumstances such as adverse weather conditions or bad light, then a count out will be used to decide the winners/qualifiers (**if any pair were eliminated during the play-off, such pair will not be part of the count out**). **The count out will be based on holes 10 to 18, then holes 13 to 18, then 16 to 18 and lastly hole 18 (as recommended by the R&A).**
- l) If there is still no winner after the above, the count out will be per hole starting from 17 back to 1.
- m) In the event of two or more teams not being separated by any of the above methods or a last resort, the winners will be decided by the toss of a coin or by drawing lots if more than 2 teams are involved.
- n) In the normal course of play, in the event of a cessation of play due to unavoidable circumstances such as adverse weather conditions or bad light and all pairs have not completed the round, the course will be deemed to be the front 9. In the event of all pairs not having completed the front 9, the course will be deemed to comprise the number of holes having been completed by the pair having completed 6 holes as long as at least the same 6 holes have been played by all the pairs competing. In the event of less than

six holes of a round having been played, the event will be re-scheduled for an alternative day (if possible). The Tournament Coordinators' decision is final.

- o) The Tournament Coordinators reserve the right to nominate a shortened course comprising at least six designated holes as may be appropriate considering the prevailing conditions.
- p) The Tournament Coordinators will determine the use of tees prior to the event and publish such rules timeously for the participating players.
- q) At the regional and SA finals, all Ladies Pairs will compete in the lady's division whether they qualified through their club or through the ladies only qualifying events.

General Notes:

All Regional Final qualifiers will receive:

- a) One round of golf, grab-and-go, and a prize-giving with snacks.
 - b) There may be further prizes from the tournament promoters and / or associated sponsors in accordance with **Rule 4-2g**.
 - c) Regional Finals winners will win a place in the National Finals.
 - d) Regional Final events will be held as follows:
 - 1) In each of the regions in which Club Qualifying events have been held, as far as possible, if there are sufficient players to warrant a Regional Final.
 - 2) As far as possible, the objective is to try and ensure no pair play at their home course in a Regional Final. The Tournament Coordinators reserve the right to allocate any pair/s to play in a Regional Final at their home course where it may not be possible due to financial, logistical, or other reasons for such pairs to play in any other regional Final.
 - 3) The number of Regional Finals held will be determined by the number of qualifying pairs.
- 9) **SA FINAL:**
- a) A maximum total of 24 (twenty-four) pairs from the Regional finals will travel to the SA finals. As well as a maximum total of 6 (six) Lady Pairs.
 - b) Players are responsible for their own travel insurance as well as required travel documents. If a player is not able to travel due to inappropriate documents, that pair will have to withdraw and will be replaced.
 - c) The National final event format is a 36-hole Betterball Stableford Competition (played over two days) with 85% handicap allowance (as per 7(d) above).
 - d) The Coordinators will check the "LOW HI" index (**for the previous 365 days**) of all players who are participating, and players will play of their **lowest handicap**

index achieved during this period, up to and including the morning of the 1st round (playing handicap will be as per 7 (d) above).

- e) All players **must** enter their score **after round 1** of the competition and the Organizers will check all handicap indexes on the morning prior to round 2. Should a player’s handicap index be lower at this stage, the player will play off the **new lower handicap index in round 2**.
- f) If two or more teams finish with the same Score, then the following will occur:
 - 1) A hole-by-hole sudden-death playoff,
 - 2) Count out procedure as prescribed for the Regional Finals **(8 k)**,
 - 3) If for any reason – such as adverse weather conditions (e.g., bad light) - interfering with the completion of the event itself or any playoff, the winners will be decided by:
 - a. The leaders after 27 holes; or
 - b. If there is no play in round 1 OR 2 and not all pairs are able to complete a minimum of 27 holes, then the leaders after the completed round 1 OR 2 will be declared the winners.
 - c. In the event of two or more teams not being separated by any of the above methods or a last resort **count out (8 k & l)**, the winners will be decided by the toss of a coin or by drawing lots if more than 2 teams are involved.
- g) It is up to the discretion of the Tournament Referee or Tournament Director to determine the suitability – or otherwise – for play to be halted or for the total cessation of play.
- h) Overall winners of the **Windhoek Lager International Pairs SA Championship** will be crowned the Windhoek Lager Club Pairs Champions and could receive an invitation to represent South Africa at the World Finals with travel to the venue and accommodation expenses paid. – Subject to all rules, regulations, and conditions as described in this document being adhered to.
- i) The second-placed pair at the National Finals could also receive an invitation to represent South Africa at the World Finals with travel to the venue and accommodation expenses paid. – Subject to all rules, regulations, and conditions as described in this document being adhered to.
- j) The two pairs participating in the World Finals will need to have passports with a minimum of nine months’ validity and will be responsible for arranging their own visas where applicable.
- k) There may be further prizes in accordance with **Rule 4-2g**.

WINDHOEKLAGER INTERNATIONAL PAIRS

- 1) All players must have an official club handicap index and the Tournament Director reserves the right to request a handicap index and membership validation from the player's golf club for Regional and National Finals.
- 2) The Tournament Director may over-ride any of these rules if the environment or situation at the time requires him or her to do so.
- 3) In the event of a pair having qualified at the Regional Finals being unable to play in the National Finals for any reason, that pair shall be substituted by the Tournament Coordinators.
- 4) If one player from a pair qualifying at the Regional Finals is unable to play in the National Finals for any reason, that pair's place shall be forfeited, and **no substitute player will be allowed.**
- 5) Right of admission to the tournament may be reserved.
- 6) At the SA final, a dedicated set of tees will be allocated to the different Categories, in this case the division for men and the division for ladies.

10) **WORLD FINALS** – to be held in the Algarve, Portugal from **26 to 30 October 2021.**

- a) South Africa now has an allocation of **two places** in the World Final.
- b) Players are responsible for their own travel insurance as well as required travel documents such as passports and visas. If a player is not able to travel due to inappropriate documents and/or reasons, that pair will have to withdraw and will be replaced.

So, there is more than enough reason for your club and members to be part of the largest amateur golf competition in the world; one that is highly competitive, cost-effective and provides the opportunity for any club golfer to potentially represent their club, region, and country against other golfers from around the country and possibly the world.
